



Dear Customer,

With regards to the 'No Deal Brexit' Looming, you need to be prepared for shipping requirements resulting from this scenario.

So, we can assist you, please note we would require some further information from you as below:

1. EORI number
2. VAT number
3. TSP number
4. Deferment account Yes / No (if yes, please provide deferment account number)
5. Tariff code for the commodities being imported / exported

If you have not obtained any of this information yet or just have partial information and would like advice on how to obtain further details, we have added further updates and links as per the below

HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC) has recently written to the 145,000 VAT-registered businesses who are currently trading with the EU regarding simplified importing procedures and with regards to EORI numbers

In summary, Transitional Simplified Procedures (TSP) for customs will be arranged for an initial period of one year, to allow businesses time to prepare for new import processes.

Once businesses are registered for TSP they will be able to transport goods from the EU into the UK without a full customs declaration at the border and can postpone any import duties payable.

Most importantly if you trade with the EU you will need to register for your Economic Operator Registration and Identification (EORI) number for both imports and exports. Your buyers or suppliers in the EU will also need to be registered, it's worth checking with them. If you import from the only the EU, you're able to register for TSP online, you will need to have received your EORI number for this:

Once businesses are registered for TSP they will be able to transport goods from the EU into the UK without a full customs declaration at the border and can defer any import duties payable.
